REGISTRATION GUIDELINE FOR ENTERING INSURANCE INFORMATION IN REGIONAL MEDITECH SYSTEMS

Approved by the Provincial Health Information Management Leadership Committee April 26, 2023 EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Background

Proper collection of insurance information is imperative to ensuring appropriate payment for services rendered. The lack of or incorrect collection of insurance information can result in the loss of millions of dollars in the health care system.

Guiding Principles

- Accurate data entry in these fields is essential to ensure proper billing so that the appropriate collection of payment for services can be implemented.
- Some services are not covered by MCP, regardless of whether the patient has valid coverage. Typically, clinicians have this discussion with the patient or Finance will determine the need for billing.
- The registration staff are responsible for asking who is responsible for the payment of the visit. There are posters at each registration area asking patients to let staff know who is responsible for payment of their visit.
- Due to the restrictions and limitations of the regional Meditech platforms, each RHA has varying processes for how to capture insurance information. Once a new Health Information System (HIS) is implemented, these processes will be standardized, and this guideline will be updated.

Procedures

The table in Appendix 1 outlines the standard registration requirements when completing the Insurances portion of the ADMISSIONS module in Meditech, during the registration process, for each RHA. Accurate data entry in these fields is essential to ensure proper billing so that the appropriate collection of payment for services can be implemented. The table demonstrates a variety of registration scenarios, states the correct way to enter the information, and provides a visual reference for each type, for each RHA.

For out-of-province health cards, the card should be photocopied (both sides) and the copy retained on the health record.

Declaration Forms will be completed as per regional policies.

Self-paying patients may be billed a pre-authorization fee, as per regional policies.
