Access to Medication Profiles Making a Difference to Patient Care

2016 has been a very exciting and busy year for the Centre and its Pharmacy Network team who have worked tirelessly to connect community pharmacies to the Pharmacy Network. Their efforts along with cooperation from community pharmacies has made a real difference to patient care in our province.

The medication profiles accessed through the provincial electronic health record, HEALTHe NL, are pulled from the Pharmacy Network. This means the medication and prescription information entered at all connected community pharmacies is now available to authorized health care professionals within a patient's

circle of care.

As one emergency room nurse explained, "HEALTHe NL is my 2:00 a.m. friend when a patient presents and there's no pharmacies open."

The week of November 28 was also the busiest week ever for Pharmacy Network connections. During that time the team connected eight pharmacies - something the Centre is very proud of as many of those connections were Walmart Pharmacies with large volumes of scripts that connected without issue.

The Centre is very pleased to report that all 12 Walmart

Pharmacies are now connected.

As of December 13, 159 pharmacies have connected to the Pharmacy Network. This represents 80 per cent of pharmacies in NL connected to the Pharmacy Network.

The Pharmacy Network team sincerely thanks community pharmacies for their commitment to patient safety, quality health care and continued support of the Pharmacy Network.

Quick Reminders

Having correct ELIDS on file

Always include the identification (ID) number of the receiving pharmacy when transferring a prescription. Without the correct pharmacy ID number, the receiving pharmacy is unable to accept the prescription from the Pharmacy Network.

• Pulling a prescription in from the PN when receiving a transfer

It's important to pull transferred-in prescriptions from the Pharmacy Network. Not only does it save you time having to create a new prescription, it ensures the prescription is entered correctly and avoids having the prescription duplicated on the patient's profile.
